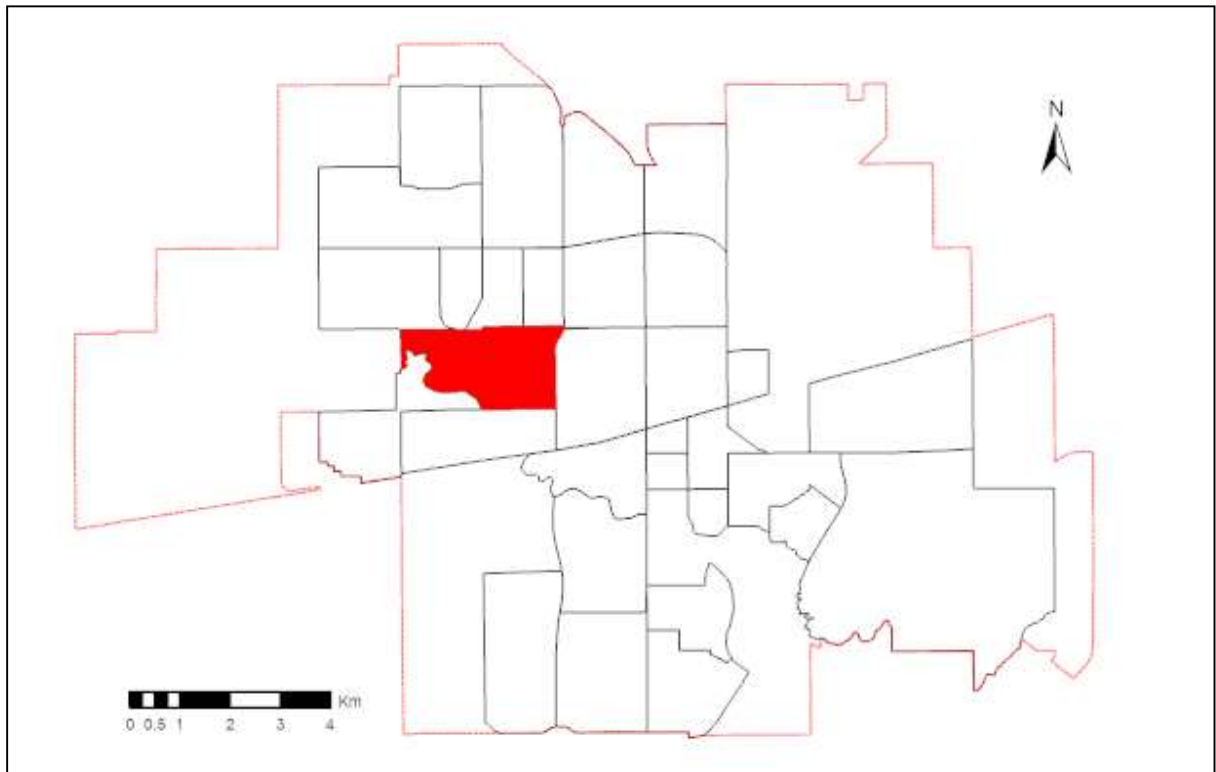




City of Regina Map with Rosemont-Mount Royal Highlighted

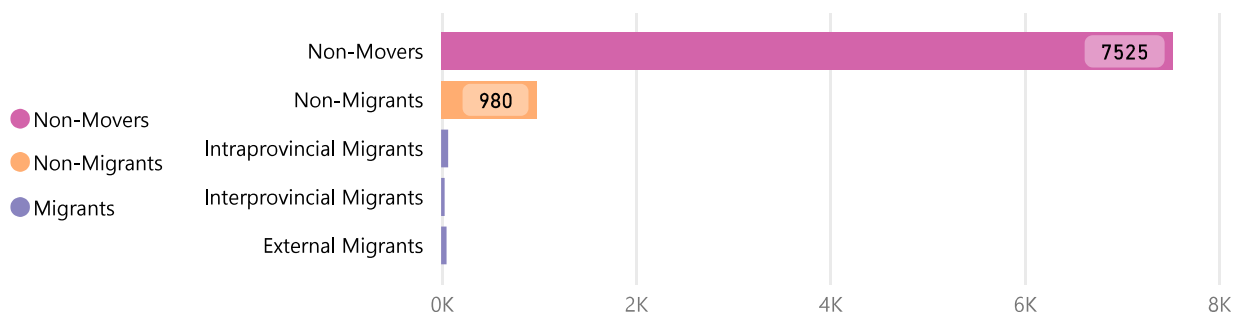

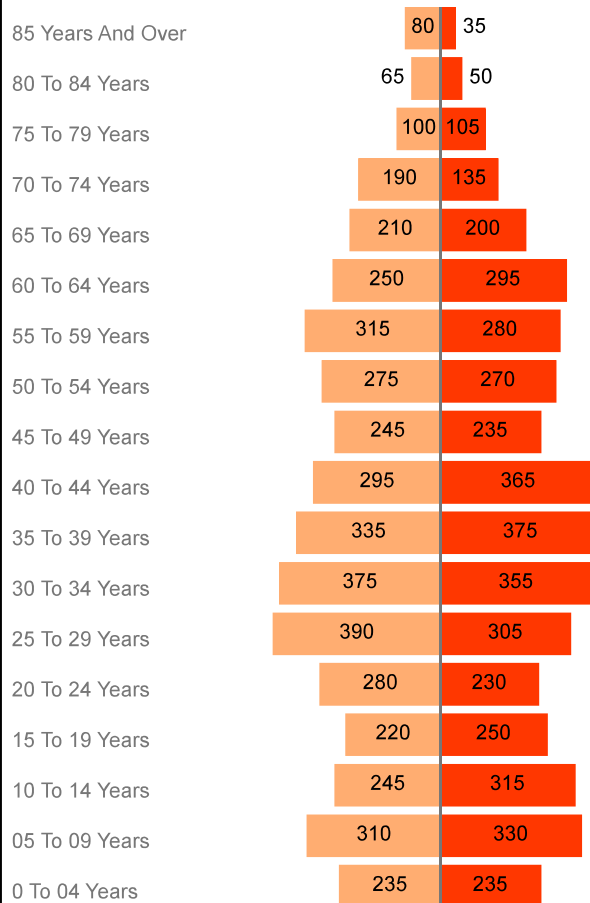

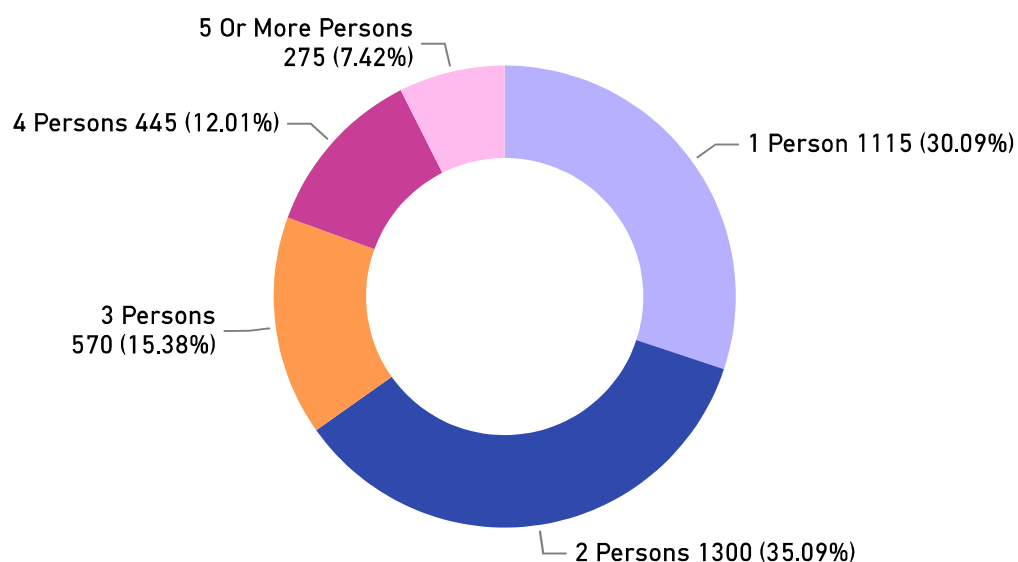

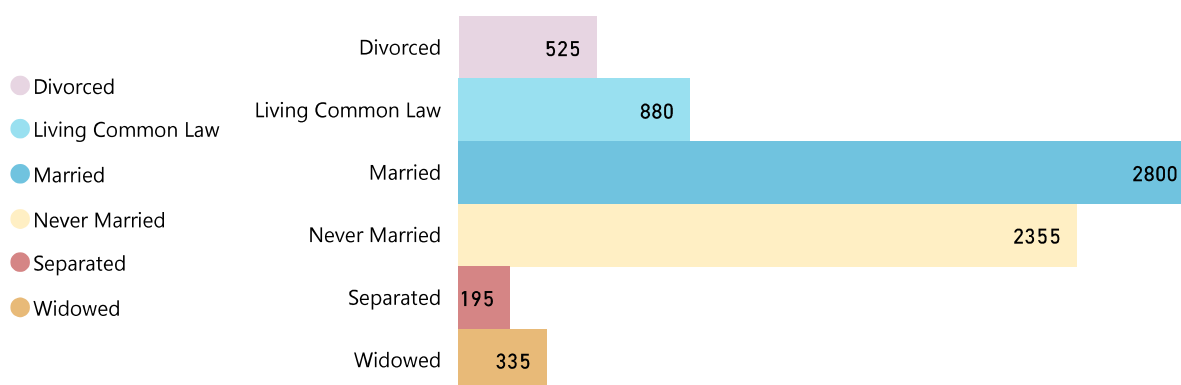

### Marital Status For The Population Aged 15 Years And Over In Private Households

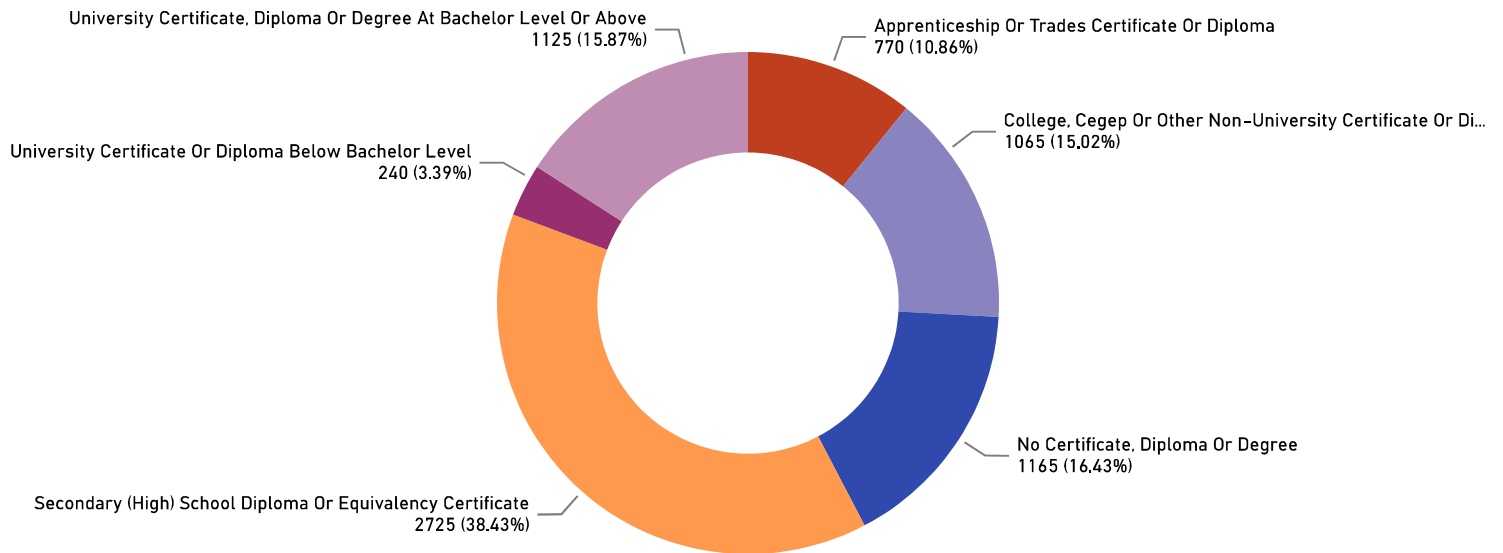

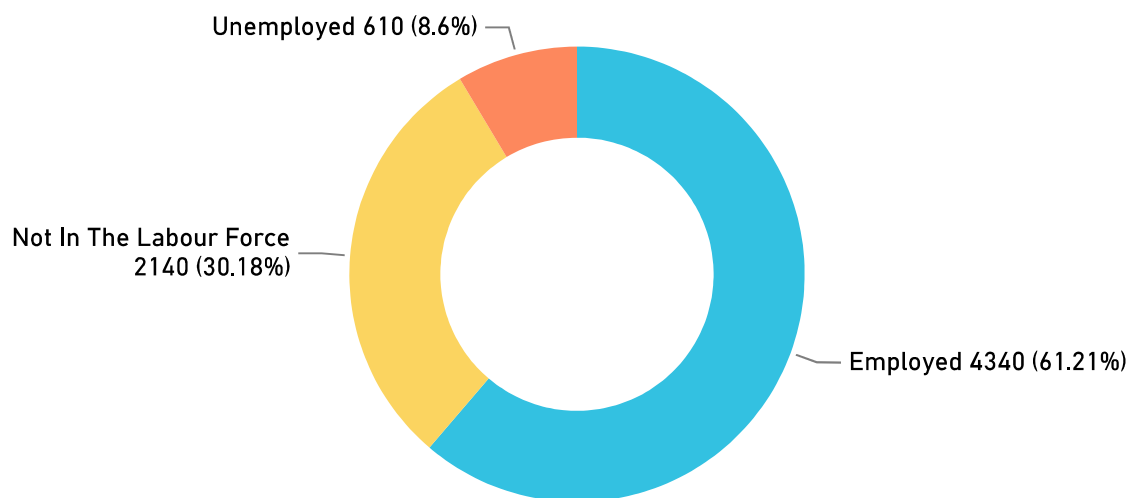

Highest Certificate, Diploma Or Degree For The Population Aged 15 Years And Over In Private Households

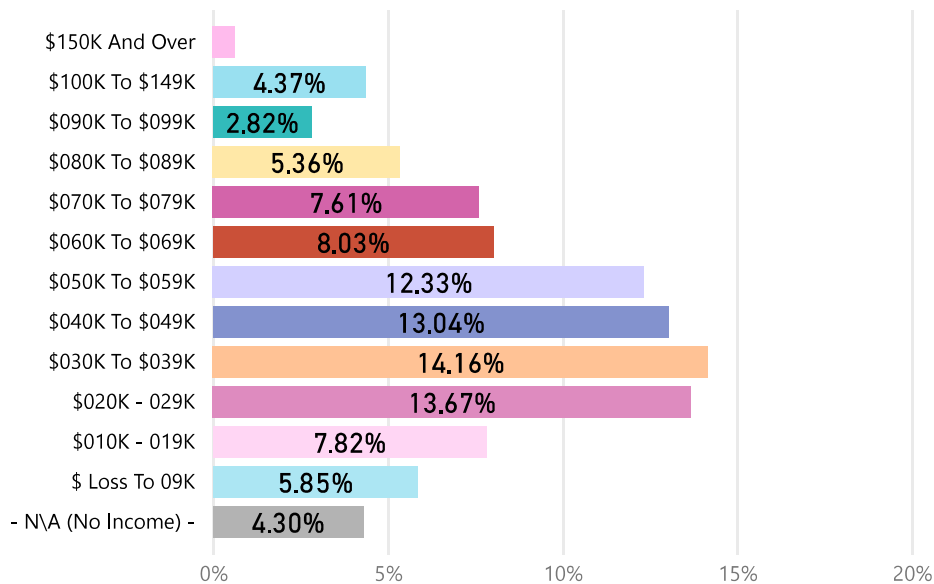


Population Aged 15 Years And Over By Labour Force Status

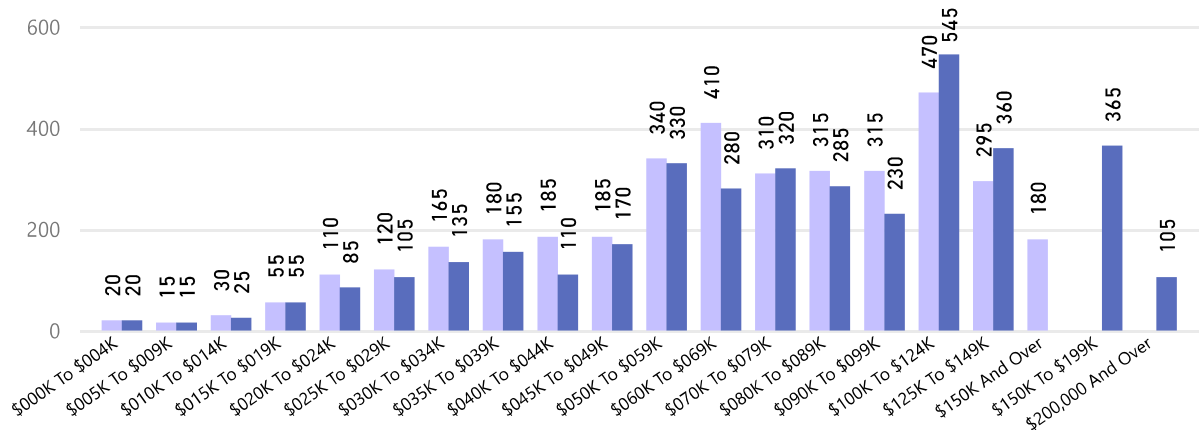

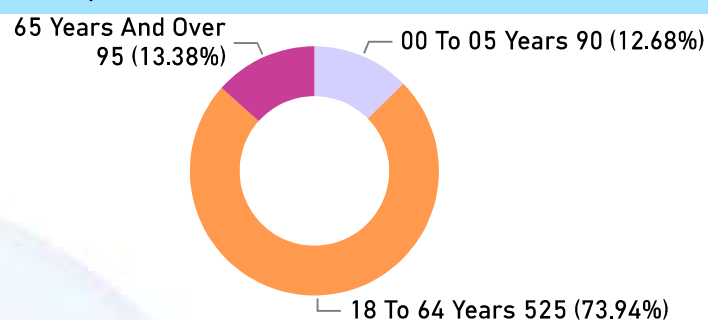

Private Households, After-Tax Income Private Households, Pretax Income

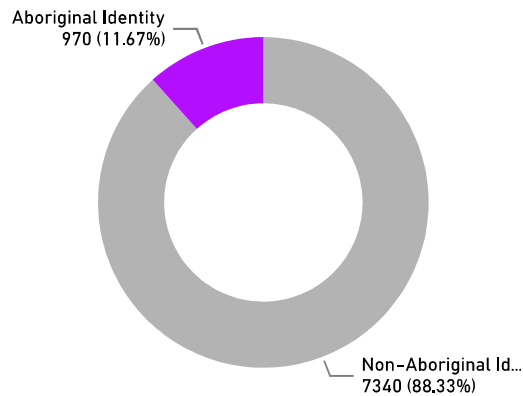


### Population, By Age Group, With After Tax Income Below The Low Income Measure

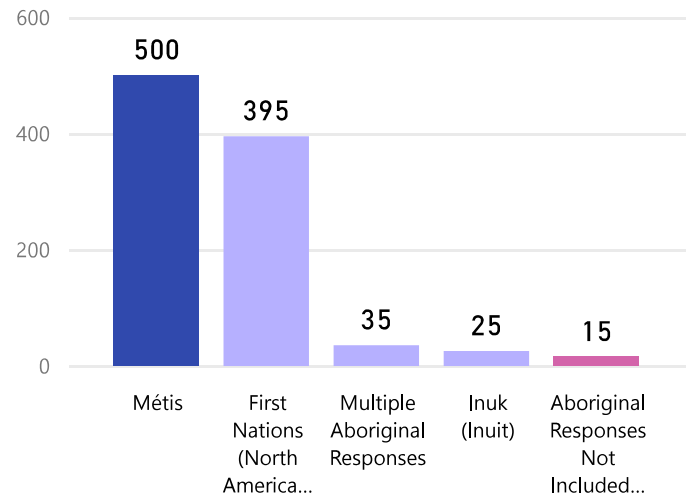

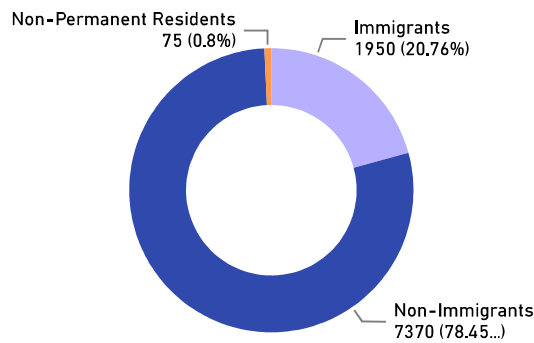
### Population By Aboriginal Identity



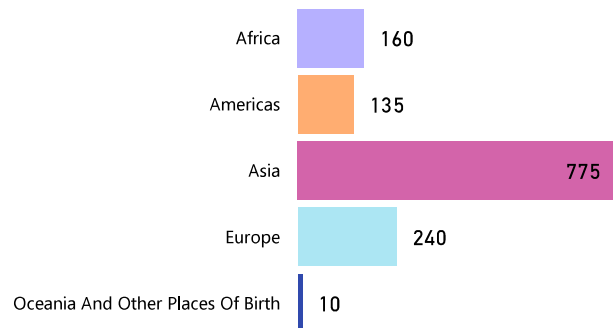
### Population By Aboriginal Identity



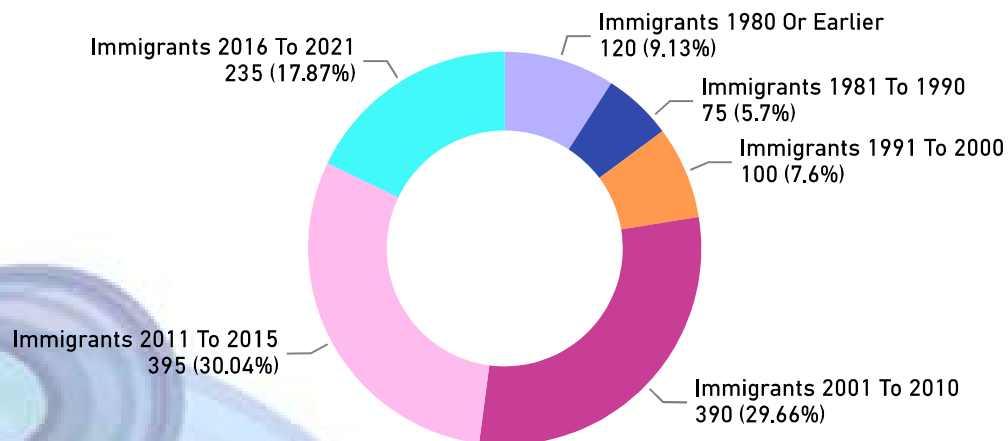
### Population By Immigration Category



### Immigrant Population By Region of Birth

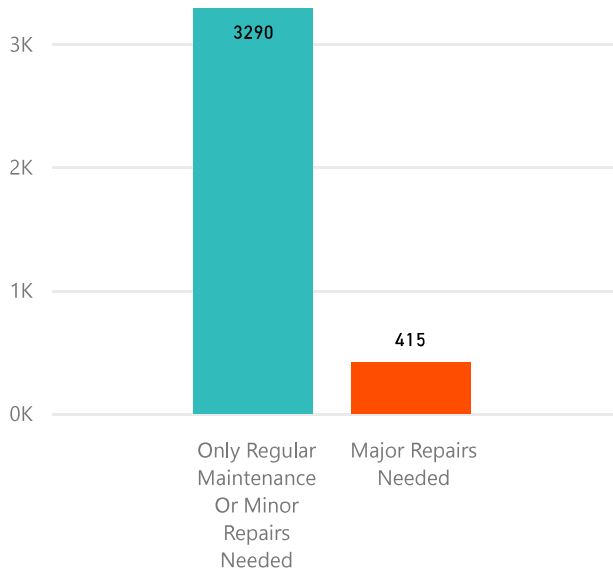


### Immigrant Population By Year Of Immigration

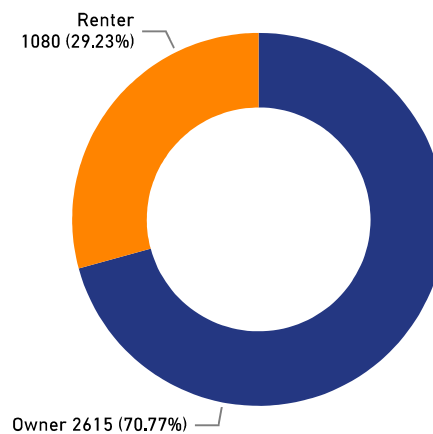

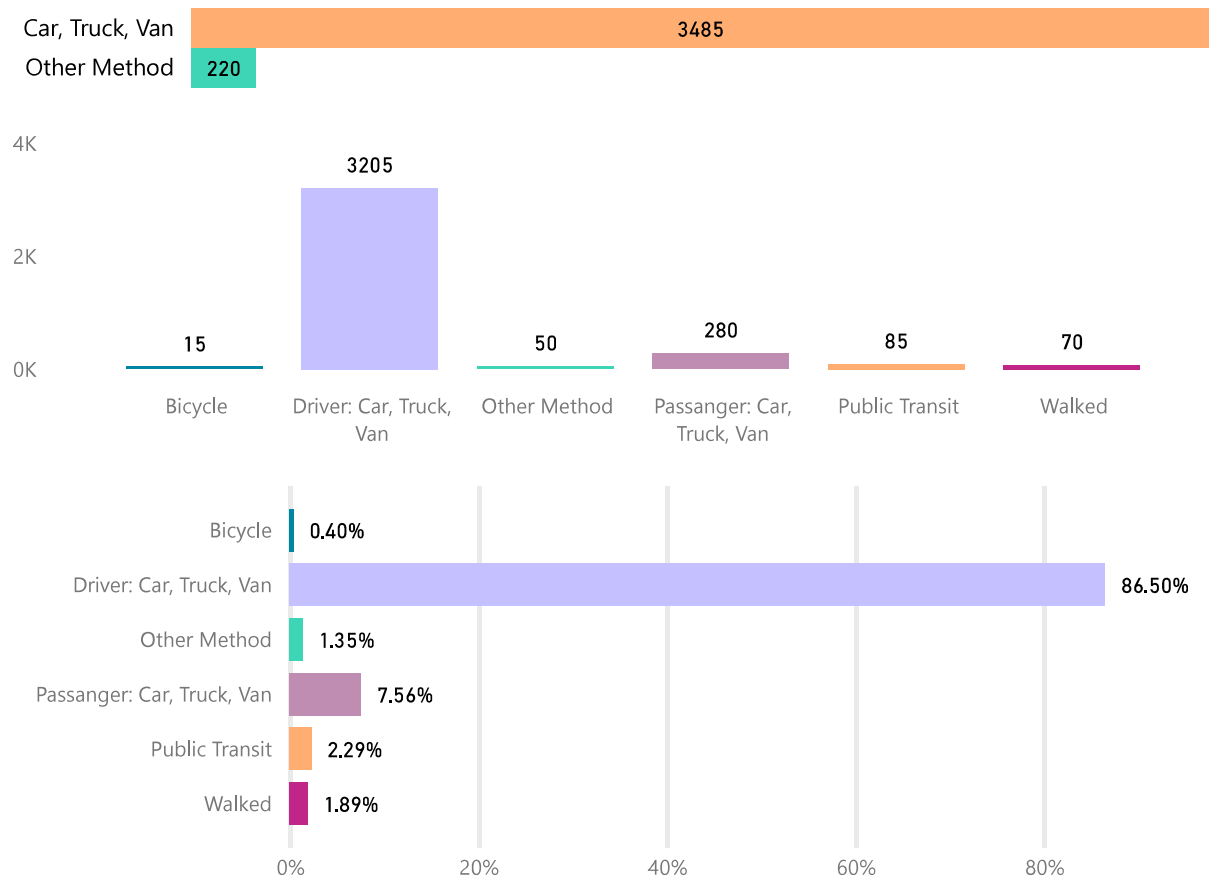
